

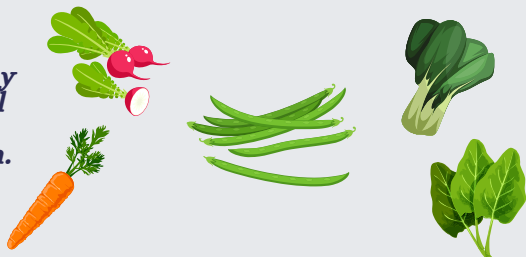
Good Company

Bring some strategy to your Veggie Garden by understanding what plants keep good company with others. Some plants offer height and shade, some offer pest control and some offer nitrogen fixing.



Sun-loving Corn lends its height to low-growing Cucumbers and Squash that can tolerate some shade. Peas and Beans conveniently climb the stalks.

Beans make great neighbors because they have a symbiotic relationship with a soil bacteria. This allows them to convert atmospheric nitrogen into plant nitrogen. This works well for Carrots, Pak Choi, Spinach & Radishes.



Some plants are naturally gifted when it comes to pest suppression and Marigolds are one of the best. Marigolds protect plants like Tomatoes from nematodes in the soil and they also repel whitefly. Basil is another pest deterrent. Tomatoes, Cucumbers, Lettuce, and Carrots keep great company as the Tomatoes grow taller and provide some shade for the more heat-sensitive crops.
