## PLACEMATS WITH POCKET USING YOUR JULY SHOPHOP 9 1/2" BLOCK

## FOR ONE PLACEMAT YOU WILL NEED

- 9 ½" BLOCK

- .40 METERS OF FABRIC FOR BORDERS AND BINDING

- BACKING A FAT QUARTER CAN BE USED IF YOU ARE QUILTING ON YOUR DOMESTIC MACHINE

**CUTTING:** 

FABRIC: Cut 1 strip the width of fabric 8"

Sub cut: 2 – 8" X 9.5"

1 - 2" X 9.5"

 $2 - 2 \times 18.5$ "

Cut 2 - 2.5" strips the width of fabric (binding)

Take one 8" X 9.5" and fold in half (should measure 8" X 4.75" place this piece on top of the 8" X 9.5" piece to make a pocket baste in place. Sew this piece onto the right side of your block this will make the centre of your placemat. Sew the 2" X 9.5" strip onto the left side of your block. Take the 2 - 2" X 18.5" strips and sew onto the top and bottom of your centre of placemat.

Quilt as you wish

Bind
