

Boxy Pouch

Materials needed:

- One 9.5" square block
- One 6.5" x 9.5" coordinating fabric
- One 10" x 16" piece of lining fabric
- One 10" x 16" piece of batting
- One 10" or longer zipper



Assembly

1. Sew your 6.5" x 9.5" coordinating fabric onto one side of your 9.5" block using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Press
2. Layer your lining fabric, batting, and pieced front together. Quilt as desired. Trim to measure 9.5" x 15.5" (image 1&2)
3. Lay a short edge right sides together with your zipper. Sew on using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Flip seam allowance toward the fabric and top stitch using a $\frac{1}{8}$ " seam allowance (image 3&4)
4. Repeat step 3 for the other side of the zipper.
5. Find the middle of the long edge of the zipper and flatten your bag so that the zipper lays directly over that middle mark. Sew the seam with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. (image 5)
6. Repeat Step 5 for the other end of the bag.
7. Mark a 1" square from the fold and the seam allowance in each of the 4 corners of the bag. Cut out each square (Image 6&7)
8. Open up the boxes and match your seam with the fold to create a straight line. Sew the corner closed using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance, making sure to back stitch at the start and end. Repeat for all 4 corners (image 8)
9. Turn your bag right side out and enjoy!
