Boxy Pouch

Materials needed:

One 9.5" square block
One 6.5" x 9.5" coordinating fabric
One 10" x 16" piece of lining fabric
One 10" x 16" piece of batting
One 10" or longer zipper

Assembly

- 1. Sew your 6.5" x 9.5" coordinating fabric onto one side of your 9.5" block using a ¼" seam allowance. Press
- 2. Layer your lining fabric, batting, and pieced front together. Quilt as desired. Trim to measure 9.5" x 15.5" (image 1&2)
- 3. Lay a short edge right sides together with your zipper. Sew on using a ¼" seam allowance. Flip seam allowance toward the fabric and top stitch using a ½" seam allowance (image 3&4)
- 4. Repeat step 3 for the other side of the zipper.
- 5. Find the middle of the long edge of the zipper and flatten your bag so that the zipper lays directly over that middle mark. Sew the seam with a 1/4" seam allowance. (image 5)
- 6. Repeat Step 5 for the other end of the bag.
- 7. Mark a 1" square from the fold and the seam allowance in each of the 4 corners of the bag. Cut out each square (Image 6&7)
- 8. Open up the boxes and match your seam with the fold to create a straight line. Sew the corner closed using a ¼" seam allowance, making sure to back stitch at the start and end. Repeat for all 4 corners (image 8)
- 9. Turn your bag right side out and enjoy!
