Dear RCA Family,

Our scholars are getting settled into their routines for the school year! We would like to take a moment to inform you of some important details specific to our Middle & High School (MS/HS) Scholars. Thank you for taking note of the following items:

- ❑ **Drop Off/Dismissal:** *All MS/HS Scholars must arrive between 8:00 a.m. and 8:20 a.m. Scholars arriving after 8:20 a.m. will need to be escorted to the office by a parent and will be marked late.* Lateness is part of your scholar's permanent attendance record, so it is important to arrive to school on time. **MS/HS dismissal is from 3:10 p.m.-3:20 p.m. Please arrive on time for your scholar.**
- ❑ **Morning Meeting:** All MS/HS Scholars will assemble for the morning meeting at 8:20 a.m. Scholars are expected to be unpacked and ready to attend their morning meeting on time. Scholars are also expected to bring their Bible to morning meeting. If your scholar needs a Bible, please see one of the school administrators.
- ❑ **Electronic Devices-** All electronic devices that have communication/online capabilities are to be "OFF AND AWAY" during the school day. This includes iPads, cell phones, earbuds, lap tops, phone watches, etc. Scholars may use the office phone as needed.
- ❑ **Class Dojo-** Class Dojo is a communication tool used by parents and teachers to communicate. If you are not yet connected, please reach out to your scholar's teacher. This will ensure that you are not missing important messages.
- ❑ **Uniforms-** All scholars are expected to be in proper uniform by Monday, October 6th. After this, you may be requested to pick up your scholar from school if he or she is in violation of our dress code. Scholars wear dress uniforms to school daily, including on PE days. Scholars may change for PE during their PE time.
- ❑ **Enrichment Programs-** We are building our enrichment schedule for the school year and partnering with parents and local business leaders to help expose our scholars to a variety of skills and life opportunities (financial literacy, engineering, EMT Training, cosmetology, carpentry, etc...).
