

About Beacon of Light Pregnancy Support Center

Beacon of Light has been serving the women and unborn babies of Orange County NY since 2003. Our mission is to advocate for women and their unborn children by providing free medical services and resources that transform their fears into confidence in a future that includes their babies, empowering parents to choose life. We envision living in a community where ALL unborn babies are given the gift of life!

The “DBA” (doing business as) name MyChoice Pregnancy Care Center was added in 2007 to represent our transition from a resource model to a medical model. In addition to material assistance and resources we offer free and confidential medical services, including medical grade pregnancy tests, limited STI testing and treatment, and limited obstetrical ultrasounds to confirm the existence and viability of a pregnancy. We provide professional care from a Registered Nurse who can answer questions regarding pregnancy, abortion, health history, sexual health, contraception and self-care. Our trained advocates provide education on each woman’s pregnancy options including the risks, side effects, recovery time and what to expect regarding abortion pills and abortion clinic procedures. We also provide information on local resources for parenting and adoption.

At MyChoice, we believe every woman should have access to the basic reproductive health services we provide, regardless of her ability to pay, from a source that does not charge or profit from her decision, so she is able to make a fully informed decision about the outcome of her pregnancy without pressure or coercion. Our nonjudgmental team of advocates and nurses provide compassionate care throughout the pregnancy journey, regardless of the path a woman may choose. All of our services are free and confidential, and are offered without regard to age, race, income, nationality, religious affiliation, disability, or other arbitrary circumstances.

The Opportunity

Beacon of Light is seeking its next Executive Director with a passion for our mission. The ideal candidate will have a strong business acumen, with experience in fundraising and team leadership. Our next leader must have a strong and abiding faith in Jesus Christ, consistent with our Statement of Faith, and the ability to confidently express those beliefs within the community. The Executive Director will lead a dedicated and compassionate team of 5 staff members and 10 volunteers. With support from the board and staff, the next Executive Director will continue to move the ministry forward in an often controversial and ever-changing environment.

This leader will be expected to increase engagement with a volunteer board of directors, donors, church partners and other potential stakeholders. With the current annual budget of approximately \$275,000, Beacon of Light is looking for a leader who can increase funding, particularly through increased church engagement and individual donors. The ED will also be charged with evaluating the efficiency of the organization's programs and the creation of new mission driven programs to ensure we are always reaching new potential clients, as we strive to educate the community about the value of all human life.
