

PUMPKIN COMPOSTING, Nov. 1-3

The Village of Winnetka has been composting discarded Halloween pumpkins for the last few years. This year, by working with a Troop 18 Boy Scout, the village is able to extend the composting collection to a second site, and offer additional hours.

After Halloween is over, please bring your pumpkins in for composting. Composting pumpkins is important for three main reasons

1. Composting returns valuable nutrients to the soil.
2. It limits the amount of methane in landfills.
3. Composting keeps pumpkins out of the leaf litter, keeping our streets safer. Leaf collection trucks cannot pick up pumpkins.

WHERE: Parking lot of **First Bank and Trust in Winnetka**, 100 Green Bay Road, corner of Green Bay Road and Winnetka Avenue.

WHEN: Nov. 1-3

NOTE: Please remove candles, and do not include painted pumpkins.
