Fort Wayne has been a significant immigrant friendly community for southeast Asian, Mexican, Burmese, and east European populations for many years. While we began welcoming Afghan refugees about 20 years ago, we are currently seeing a surge in Afghan immigrants due to the drastic measures taken after the US military withdrew from Afghanistan last year.

A group of our members have been meeting with Reverend Sara to accomplish two major things relative to the surge in Afghan immigrants.

- 1. Work with Catholic Charities ('CC') and our own Terry Dougherty, to discern the needs presented by the Afghan immigrants appearing on our community's doorstep. These needs fall into the following general categories: housing, transportation, employment, food availability, education, cultural integration, medical (both physical and mental/emotional), and legal (i.e., applying for asylum and/or visas). Within each of these general categories are multiple levels of specificity.
- 2. Determine the specific activities required to meet those needs, survey the congregation to determine what needs our members and friends can help meet by identifying which of the specific activities members and friends are willing to perform. These activities are how you can become involved if you desire. On the following page is a table on which you can enter your name, phone number and email address, and then check the activity/activities you would like to volunteer to perform.

The first section of the attached document lists activities that require a volunteer to complete a background check and TB test. CC owns the process to meet these two requirements. If you desire to volunteer for any of the activities in this first section, we will contact you with the information and documentation you need to meet these two requirements.

The second section of the attached document lists activities that do not require a background check and TB text. Your completion and submission of this form will be all we need to contact you about your participation.
