Count of Members Present: Roger Eversole confirmed a quorum

Cammy Sutter, Moderator, called the meeting to order *at 11:06am*

Rev. Sara Ofner-Seals provided an opening prayer.

Cammy shared that the agenda and slate of nominated officers are in the digital bulletin. They have also been on display in the Folsom room and some paper copies were offered and distributed.

Approval of Minutes of the 1.26.25 Annual Business Meeting: *Motioned by Diane Lasley, seconded Toby Watson, approved by the congregation.*

There is a maximum capacity of 50 people. It will be held Nov. 22 from 10-4pm. There is a fee of \$20 and scholarships are available if needed. An RSVP is needed and lunch will be provided.
