#### Substance Abuse Evaluation

Performed by a CADC or LCADC in person at a provider agency or through CSOC Intensive In-Community (IIC) services  
Includes an ASAM level of care determination  
May include drug test

Payment options:

- ◆ Private health insurance/self pay
- ◆ Children's System of Care (CSOC) contracted providers covered by grant
- ◆ County funding

Probation has access to YSC grant funded provider agency for substance abuse evals (Bright Harbor Healthcare)

## Ocean County Adolescent Substance Use Treatment (SUT) Services

**(Accessible to youth up to age 18 yrs/Detox and residential up to 21 yrs) (SUT services are not Medicaid reimbursable for youth under 18 yrs old for in-patient but can be used for outpatient).**

#### ASAM Level 1.0

##### Outpatient

Less than 6\* hours of service/week for recovery or motivational enhancement therapies/ strategies

- Teen Intervene @ Preferred Behavioral Health
- Turnaround @ Bright Harbor Healthcare (for Bayside participants only)

#### ASAM Level 1.0 Intensive In-Community (IIC) #

If youth is CMO or MRSS involved, youth can access in-home substance use specific therapy. # of hours of services determined by need. On average, 1-2 hours per week.

#### ASAM Level 2.1

##### Intensive Outpatient (IOP)

6\* or more hours of service/week; to treat multidimensional instability

- Stress Care (substance use as co-occurring).

\* None for adolescents

#### ASAM Level 2.5

##### Partial Hospitalization

20 or more hours of service/week for multidimensional instability not requiring 24 hour care

- Iron Wellness#
- GenPsych@
- Stress Care (substance use as co-occurring).

\* None for adolescents

#### ASAM Level 3.1

##### Halfway House (Clinically-Managed Low-Intensity Residential)

24 hour structure with available trained personnel; at least 5 hours of clinical service/ week

- None for adolescents

##### Detoxification
