### **Grief Share is Coming!**

What is Grief Share? Grief Share is a program featuring Biblical, Christ-centered teaching that focuses on grief topics associated with the death of a loved one. The DVD seminar features nationally-respected grief experts and real-life stories of people followed by a small group discussion about what was viewed.

Many grieving people find that they are only beginning the work of healing when friends or family have already returned to their daily routines. Too often, people, including Christians, tend to stuff their grief instead of allowing it to do the God-given work for which it is intended. Do not allow fear of what others may think to keep you from what could help you.

Your bereavement experience may be recent or not so recent. You will find encouragement, comfort, and help in grieving the death of a spouse, child, parent, sibling, other family member, or friend. No matter what the cause of your loved one's death, this is an opportunity to be around people who understand what you are feeling. You will learn how to recognize the symptoms of being stuck in grief and that you do not need to live in bondage to certain emotions. You will learn valuable information about facing your new normal in life and renewing your hope for the future.

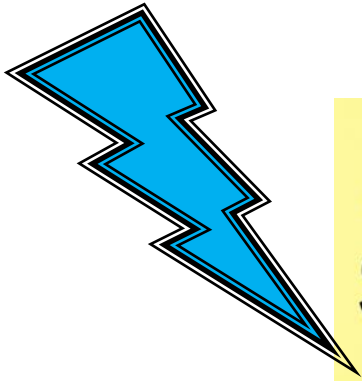
Many Thanks to all those who volunteered their time the week of VBS to make this ministry outreach such a success! We could not have done any of this without YOU!
