### **FAMILY PROMISE HOST WEEK JULY 25 – AUGUST 1 VOLUNTEERS NEEDED**

It is hard to believe that it has been 2 full years since we have opened our church doors to Family Promise. That doesn't mean we haven't supported this ministry. We continued to provide housing and supplies during the pandemic through your financial generosity. Now, we are happy to announce, that with Pastor Jacquie's blessing, we will once again host up to 3 temporarily homeless families at the church.

**There are a lot of moving parts to having a successful host week. We couldn't do it without all of our faithful volunteers. Thank you to all who have participated in the past! There is always a need for new volunteers,** especially when we host over the summer because people are often travelling. Listed below are ways you can participate in this very worthwhile ministry:

- **Slumber Hosts** – We need a male and female host every evening to spend the night at the church. The church provides a very nice, high air mattress for our host. You just need to bring your own pillow and linens. **Slumber hosts need to be at the church by 7:00pm and will be gone by 5:15am.** Your volunteering provides these families with a safe, comfortable place to sleep.
- **Donate Food Items** – Food items are needed for snacks at the church and breakfast and lunches at the Family Promise day center downtown. Items **needed will be posted in the back of the church on Sundays July 11<sup>th</sup> and July 18<sup>th</sup>.** Perishable food needs to be brought to the church the day the families arrive or a few days preceding it. There will be a refrigerator marked Family Promise to place them in. A bin will be provided for non-perishable items by the Family Promise display in the back of the sanctuary.
- **Provide a Meal** – **The host church provides a hot meal each evening for the families.** A small group, family or individual can volunteer to do this. In addition, we provide breakfast at the church Saturday and Sunday mornings. **The church also provides a bag lunch for departure Sunday.**
- **Help with Laundry** – The church provides linens for each family member to use during the week. These **linens need to be laundered and packed away after the week is completed.**

**COVID** – All necessary COVID precautions will be followed. It is good to note that **not one Family Promise staff person or program participant contracted COVID during the pandemic.**
