Family Promise Making Big Strides for Families Finding Themselves Temporarily Homeless

Family Promise Jacksonville overcame many challenges to have a banner year in 2020 helping families overcome temporary homelessness. While many Family Promise affiliates across the county had to suspend services for a period of time, **Family Promise Jax continued to operate at full capacity**. No family member or staff contracted COVID.

Some interesting statistics that show the impact Family Promise Jax makes are:

Forty-nine families with 172 family members were served in 2020.

83% of the families moved in to housing.

100% of the families had medical needs addressed.

95% of the children were placed in school or daycare.

67% of adults were employed when they graduated from the program.

Family Promise Jax partnered with 40 social service agencies to meet the needs of these families.

89% of funds received go directly to programming.

Our church is proud to be a part of this network that is changing people's lives.
