Attend the Packing Party- We will have a packing party on Wednesday, November 19 starting at 5:30.

Donate to the shipping costs. The boxes cost \$10 each to ship. Donating to this cause will help with the cost of the shoeboxes we pack during our packing party. (Be sure to write OCC on your donation to PVC.)

Get your small group involved! It would be awesome if all the small groups would pack boxes for needy children.

Last year we packed 147 boxes. Let's try to beat that goal this year and make more children happy!


