Family Promise 2022

On August 14-21st our church will be welcoming up to 3 temporarily homeless families from Family Promise Ministry. It takes approximately 40 hands-on volunteers to host on-site. This number doesn't include the large number of members who generously donate supplies. Below is a list of opportunities if you would like to help serve:

- **Provide a hot meal for up to 14 people** – Dinner Friday night or Saturday night, and breakfast on Sunday. If you can help, please contact Corrine Garrison at corrine13@comcast.net.
- **Overnight Hosts** – We need 1-2 females and 5 males to spend one night at the church. You will be staying in your own private room with a queen-sized air mattress. An orientation will be held before the host week starts.
- **Laundry Volunteers** – People are needed to do 1-2 sets of linens at the close of the host week. Bags of laundry can be picked up at the end of each service on August 21st and should be returned the following Sunday, August 28th.
- **Supplies** – Items that we need donated for the week are located at the Family Promise display table at the back of the sanctuary. Please take a sticky note with the item you would like to donate then put your name, item donating, and email address on the sign-up sheet.
- **Air Mattresses** – If you have experience inflating and deflating air mattresses, we could use your help on Sunday arrival and departure to inflate and deflate the 2 queen mattresses in the hosts' rooms.

Important: *please make sure you give your email address if you have signed up to serve. Email is our main method of communication.*

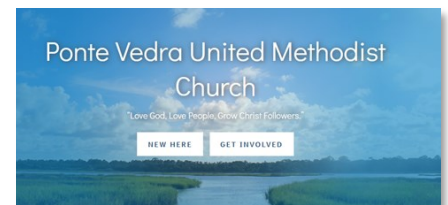
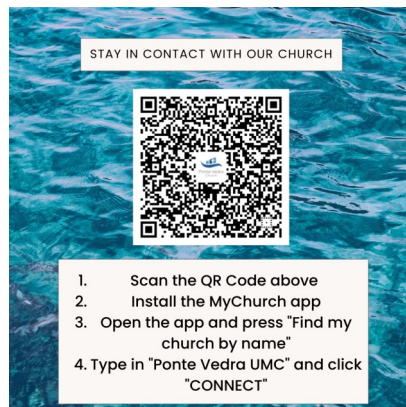
