What is UPSkill?

Upskill is an online learning opportunity administered by Arkansas State University for high school students who desire to develop a variety of in-demand job skills. This program offers students an affordable, flexible and convenient learning experience in which they can develop skills to expand their future opportunities in a growing digital world.

What About the Courses?

Upskill with Arkansas State University consists of two pathways.

Each pathway is a nine-month program that consists of three asynchronous online courses taught in an seven-week format. Students will take two courses in the fall semester and one course in the spring. Each week students will have modules to work through. At the conclusion of the final course, students will have created a final project, such as an application.

How to Get Started

Schools interested in participating in this grant program must call the Arkansas Public School Resource Center at (501)492-4300 to complete a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) no later than **May 22, 2025**. Once the MOU is complete, students will complete an application for admission that must be completed by **August 20, 2025**.
