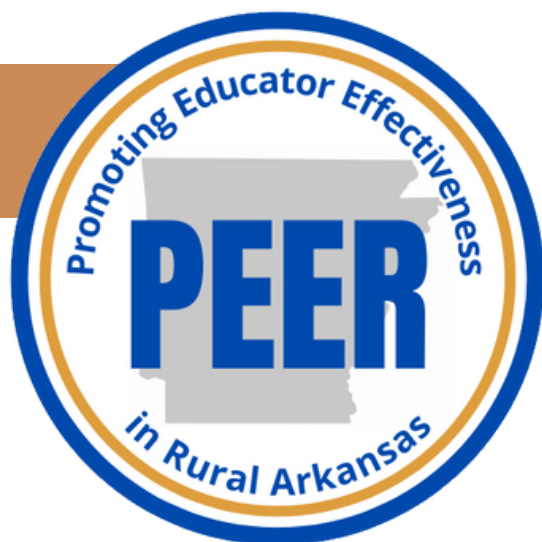

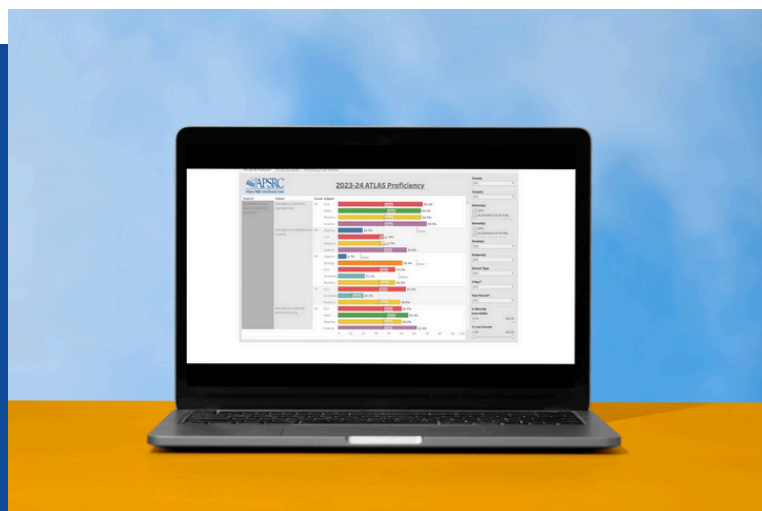
APSRC Annual Fall Conference
