Eligibility requirements:

- * Each candidate must have been enrolled in 4-H for at least 3 years previously and be currently enrolled as a Douglas/Sarpy 4-Her.
- * Candidates for Emerald 4-Her must be completing their sophomore year in high school.
- * Candidates for Diamond 4-Her must be completing their junior year in high school.

The applications will be judged by a 4-H extension office from a county other than Douglas/Sarpy. The applications will be judged based on the submissions that follow the Douglas/Sarpy County Showcase of 4-H Gems Application Form guidelines.

All applications are due to the Douglas-Sarpy Extension South or Central office by July 12, 2024. They can also be e-mailed to rwright4@unl.edu (please list 4-H Gems Showcase in the subject line).

Please include a picture of yourself for the display board at the county fair (5x7 or smaller) which can be picked up at the end of the fair. If you are emailing your picture, please attach a file, do not paste it into email.

The Showcase of 4-H Gems will be held at 5pm on Thursday August 1, 2024, at the fairgrounds. Two 4-Hers will be named Diamond 4-Her and two 4-Hers will be named Emerald 4-Her.

In honor of your accomplishments

The Diamond 4-Hers will each receive a \$250 scholarship for post high school education. The Emerald 4-Hers will each receive \$150 scholarships.

Things to include in your application/resume

- Highlight your special 4-H achievements, projects & activities.
- Highlight community service involvement.
- Highlight school achievements including extracurricular school activities.
- Briefly list your hobbies & interests outside of 4-H.
- Explain your future goals.
- Highlight your most memorable 4-H experience.
- Why do you want to be honored as a 4-H Gem?
