To continue making progress in our fight against COVID-19, Governor Larry Hogan has established a goal of testing 10 percent of the Maryland population. “Widespread testing is critical to saving lives and safely reopening more and more of our economy, which is why state health officials are setting a goal of testing 10 percent of the population in all of our 24 jurisdictions,” said Governor Hogan.

To achieve this crucial milestone, the Maryland Department of Health (MDH) is seeking the support of Medicaid providers in contacting Medicaid participants and encouraging them to seek a COVID-19 test. Please note as per Directives, anyone that wants to be tested can be tested.
