HRDC 7 Helps Households impacted by COVID-19

HRDC 7 is dedicated to assisting households that have been impacted by COVID-19. If you have experienced the loss of a job or income due to the pandemic, we may be able to help. Through the agency's Adaptive Technology Program; eligible participants affected by the virus can receive supportive services that help them to secure essential school supplies, internet access, and even technology devices such as a smartphone, pad, or computer to help individuals continue their education, or find a job.



HRDC 7 offers Emergency Essential Service Programs to provide temporary, transitional, and permanent housing to low-income individuals and families. These programs provide rental payment and housing deposit assistance. They can also assist COVID impacted households with utilities, including water.

HRDC 7 administers an Emergency Energy Program to provide relief for households that have been directly affected by COVID-19. While the agency also offers the Low Income Energy Assistance Program (LIEAP), Energy Share, and Weatherization, it can also provide Emergency Energy Assistance to households.

During these difficult times, the agency supports Youth Employment and Training programs. It assists low-income individuals to be placed at a Work Experience (WEX) site, helping them to increase their skills, knowledge, and abilities in preparation for employment.

HRDC 7 also offers a bundled services program through FAMILY FORWARD, helping eligible participants receive multiple services at one time. If transportation is an issue, HRDC can provide gas and bus vouchers to support COVID impacted households. If you are a Yellowstone County resident the agency may be able to assist with car repairs, insurance, and other vehicle issues to support employment through its Wheels for Work Program.

Households applying for COVID-19 Emergency assistance may also receive support for prescriptions that you may not be able to afford. If food or other essential needs are an issue contact us we may be able to help.
