Indiana VW Onroad and Nonroad Round 3

Funding Type: Grant

Agency: Indiana Department of Environmental Management

Purpose: Fund early repowers and replacements for older diesel vehicles and equipment in Indiana.

Program Status: Open

Due Date: June 1, 2021 by 5pm ET

Eligible Entities: Public and private entities

Eligible Vehicles or Station Types: Class 4-8 trucks, Class 4-8 buses, freight switcher locomotives, ferry and tugboats, airport ground support, and cargo handling equipment.

Eligible Fuels: CNG; Diesel; Fuel Cell; Hybrid Electric; LNG; Battery Electric; Plug-In Hybrid Electric; Propane

Eligible GVWR: Between 14,001 lbs. and 80,000 + lbs.

Eligible Geographic Location: All vehicles and equipment must be primarily operated in Indiana, and onroad vehicles must be registered in Indiana.

Maximum Solicitation Funding: \$12 million

Maximum Vehicle/Infrastructure Funding: 75% of total cost

Maximum Applicant Funding: \$2,000,000

Maximum Project Funding: \$2,000,000 (minimum \$50,000)

Stackability: Funds may be stacked with federal funding sources.

Scrapage Requirement: Yes, scrappage is required within 90 days

Special Lease Provisions: Leases are not eligible.

Operational Requirement: Onroad vehicles must operate a minimum of 7,000 miles per year. Offroad equipment must operate a minimum of 1,000 hours per year.

Reporting Requirement: Grantee must maintain grant records for minimum 3 years following final payment for inspection. Grantee must also submit annual financial reports during this time period.

PO and Deployment Timing: Projects must be complete by December 31, 2022. The program accepts no obligation for costs incurred by the applicant in anticipation of being awarded a grant.
