

CCN CONFIRMATION CLASS SERVICE PROJECT

This year's Confirmation Class is beginning its CityReach service project to learn about and serve the homeless in Boston. The first step in this project is collecting donations of the homeless' most-needed clothing and personal hygiene items from our Church community. The Confirmands will then help distribute these items to the homeless directly at Common Cathedral in downtown Boston on April 30. Nylon jackets & raincoats, sweatshirts & sweaters, casual shirts and pants, comfortable boots & shoes, **new** socks and underwear, and travel-size toiletries are among the most-needed items. The full list of needed clothing and personal hygiene items can be found on the back bag, or in our weekly eBlast. Beginning **today**, you can drop these items off at the designated collection bins in Upper Parish Hall. Used Clothing Items

- Nylon jackets, ponchos, and raincoats
- Sweatshirts and sweatpants (especially hooded sweatshirts)
- Sweaters
- T-shirts
- Long-sleeve shirts
- Jeans, khakis and other casual pants
- Waterproof boots, comfortable shoes, and sneakers
- Hats, waterproof gloves, scarves
- Belts
- Sleeping bags & blankets
- All kinds of carrying cases such as backpacks, tote bags, fanny packs, small suitcases with wheels

New Personal Hygiene Items

- **New** white socks (there can never be too many of these)
- **New** underwear for both men and women, and bras (again, there can never be too many. All sizes, from small to XL needed.)
- **Travel-size** toiletries such as soap, shampoo, deodorant, lotion, chapstick, toothpaste, and shaving cream ***in small sizes***.
- Toothbrushes, disposable razors, and tampons
