Coach Bus Trip to Hubertus, WI

Dinner at Fox & Hounds Restaurant & Tavern

Throughout sacred history, mountains and hills have held great significance as places of encounters with God. Holy Hill is no exception. The first resident was a hermit who came to the hill in mid-1800's. He found an old French diary and map dated 1676 – showing a cone-shaped mountain in WI. The diary described how the author placed a stone altar, raised a cross, and dedicated the hill to Jesus' mother Mary. As pilgrims began flocking to the shrine it was decided that a religious order should administer the shrine. A group of Discalced Carmelites came from Bavaria at the invite of Archbishop Messmer, and the shrine of Mary was put under their care on June 26, 1906, and they have been the custodians ever since.

Let's visit the **Basilica** (floors are terrazzo, pews are hand-carved oak, metal work is hand wrought iron and bronze and the stained-glass windows depict the life of the Blessed Virgin Mary), **Scenic Tower** (if open: optional climb of 178 steps to enjoy a magnificent view of the changing leaves), **Outdoor Way of the Cross** (14 stations with life-size sculptured figures), **The Lourdes Grotto** (scene of the apparition of Virgin Mary to St. Bernadette in Lourdes, France in 1858) and **Gift Store**.

Fox & Hounds Story: In 1845, the first clerk of WA county built a quaint, one-room cabin in the wooded, rolling hills of the Northern Kettle Moraine. Nearly 90 years later, Ray Wolf, an avid horseman, restored the cabin, added a basement bar and opened it to fellow equestrians. It soon became headquarters for many a fox hunt, and so the name, "Fox & Hounds" was a natural when the Wolfs opened their restaurant in 1933.

12:45 pm: Arrive at Tallent Hall – display your parking permit in your car.

1 pm: Coach bus leaves promptly for Holy Hill Basilica, Hubertus, WI.

2:15 pm: Arrive at the Basilica and take in all the autumn beauty that is Holy Hill.

3:15 pm: We split into three groups.

3:15 – 4 pm: Group 1: If open, climb the 178 stairs of the scenic tower for magnificent views. Group 2: View the Lourdes Grotto and the Outdoor Way of the Cross as you make your way down the hill. Group 3: Hang out around the Basilica.

4 pm: The bus will collect groups 1 & 3 and then drive down to the end of the 14th station at the bottom of the hill to collect group 2.

4:30 pm: Arrive at the Fox & Hounds Restaurant & Tavern

4:30 – 6 pm: Enjoy dinner at the Fox & Hounds.

7:30 pm: Approximate arrival at Tallent Hall.
