Max & Benny's Catered Lunch at the Museum

Take a docent-led tour of the Zev & Shifra Karkomi Holocaust Exhibition and explore pre-war European life, the rise of Nazism, the Holocaust, and post-war experiences of survivors as they resettled in Skokie, IL. See more than 500 artifacts, including a German rail car. A film concludes this exhibit which connects the lessons of the Holocaust with other genocides of the world.

Meet virtual Holocaust survivor, Fritzie Fritzshall as she recounts her harrowing story when at 13, she was ripped from her home and transported to Auschwitz, the notorious concentration camp where most of her family was murdered. After watching this short intro film, you will be able to ask questions to hologram Fritzie and other survivors in this award-winning innovative exhibition.

I'll Have What She's Having: The Jewish Deli explores how Jewish immigrants imported and adapted traditions to create a uniquely American restaurant. This traveling exhibition reveals how the Jewish delicatessens became a cornerstone of American food culture.
