

Take a historical walking tour of Old Northside Kenosha
followed with lunch at Kaiser's Pizza.

Tuesday, July 9, 2024 - 10 am – 1:30 pm

Self-drive Veteran's Memorial Park, 625 52nd Street, Kenosha, WI 53140.
Using Google maps, Veteran's Park is 5 miles/11 minutes from UWP.

The Old Northside Historic Walking Tour is expected to last 90 minutes and will make its way through the old north side of Kenosha: "over the Rhine". Historically, the neighborhood was a mix of workers and business owners, primarily immigrants from Central and Eastern Europe, and shows a slice of life in the self-contained urban neighborhood of the past. The tours are led by volunteer historians, who grew up in the neighborhood. If it rains, we will do an inside docent-led tour of the Kenosha History Center and nearby Southport Lighthouse.

Meet at the Veteran's Memorial Park, in front of the fountain at 10 am. Street parking is nearby.
