In a series of five classes Greg Berg will lead us through ten upcoming operas that you can see on your own, **Live in HD**, at the Renaissance Theater in Sturtevant or the Tinseltown Theater in Kenosha. You'll be sure to enjoy this class even if you don't attend all of the theater performances.

**GREGORY BERG**, our instructor. Professor Berg is on the music faculty at Carthage College in Kenosha, where he teaches voice and directs the opera productions. He is also Minister of Music at Holy Communion Lutheran Church in Racine and has been the Morning Show host on WGTD FM 91.1 since 1986. Greg is also a frequent soloist with the Racine and Kenosha Symphony Orchestras. In 1982 he graduated from Luther College-Decorah, Iowa with a double major in music and religion, and then earned his M.A. in Vocal Performance from the University of Nebraska at Lincoln. Later he served in an apprenticeship with the Chicago Lyric Opera Center for American Artists, a group of 12 singers selected from a pool of almost 500 applicants nationwide. Greg's awards for singing include four first-place finishes in NATS competitions, plus a victory in the 1984 District Metropolitan Opera Auditions.
