Doctor Brownson has graciously agreed to continue her recent presentation with a Part II class. She will start where we left off with the 1967 War and Israeli military occupation and rule of the Palestinian territories. It will address the settler movement in Israel, the First Intifada (literally “shaking off”; uprising against military rule), the emergence of Hamas, the failures of the Oslo Accords and Camp David 2000, the Palestinian Authority, the Second Intifada, and Israel’s 17-year siege of Gaza. Finally, the class will cover the U.S.’s role in the conflict and how it has changed since the Cold War.



ABOUT OUR PRESENTER:

[Elizabeth Brownson](#) is associate professor of history at the University of Wisconsin-Parkside, where she has been a faculty member since 2012. After undergraduate study at Colorado State, Brownson completed her M.A. and Ph.D. from the University of California, Santa Barbara, where she received a Fulbright-Hays fellowship to complete her dissertation. Her research has focused on Palestinian women’s status in Muslim family law since the British Mandate period and MFL reform today. In addition to her book, *Palestinian Women and Muslim Family Law in the Mandate Period*, Dr. Brownson is the author of several peer-reviewed articles and book chapters. In October of 2021, she spoke to us about “Women of Afghanistan.”
