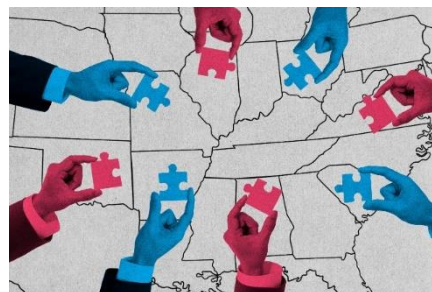




DOES MY VOTE COUNT?- Redistricting
