Deep-Dish Pizzas

Originally invented in the 40's, the Chicago Deep-Dish pizza is typically characterized by tall flaky crust holding thick layers of mozzarella cheese, and chunky tomato sauce.

Enjoy three types of pizza:

1. Original Deep-Dish with pepperoni, mushrooms, and sliced tomatoes.
2. Thin Crust with Italian sausage, green peppers, and black olives.
3. Original Deep-Dish Vegetarian with mushrooms, roasted sweet peppers, and spinach.
