

SG-MENA Educational Resources-Yemen

As we prepare for our 3rd annual MENA Monday, a fundraiser for the needs in Middle East North Africa we wanted to provide families and the church some resource to use with children. We are focusing this year on the country of Yemen and the incredible humanitarian needs; most notably food insecurity.

Included in this package are three modules:

- 1) **A Bible lesson based on I Kings 10:1-10,13** The Queen of Sheba Visits King Solomon.

The goal is to introduce:

- a. the link between present day Yemen and the Bible text.
- b. the needs of the people in Yemen today.
- c. to include a little math, geography, music, biblical history, and art for home schoolers.

This lesson is adaptable for pre-middle school aged children.

- 2) **Paul and Generosity.** This lesson uses portions of 2nd Corinthians 8 and 9.

The goal is to:

- a. Introduce Paul's missionary journeys
- b. Introduce a food crisis in Paul's day
- c. Highlight a food crisis today in Yemen
- d. Explain Paul's teaching on generosity
- e. Encourage age/resource appropriate generosity

This lesson is adaptable for pre-middle school aged children.

- 3) **Crisis in Yemen**

- a. Yemen-current status
- b. Food insecurity
- c. History of the crisis
- d. Refugees, Asylum Seekers, and Internally Displaced People
- e. Call to Action

This lesson is geared for Junior High to Adult.
