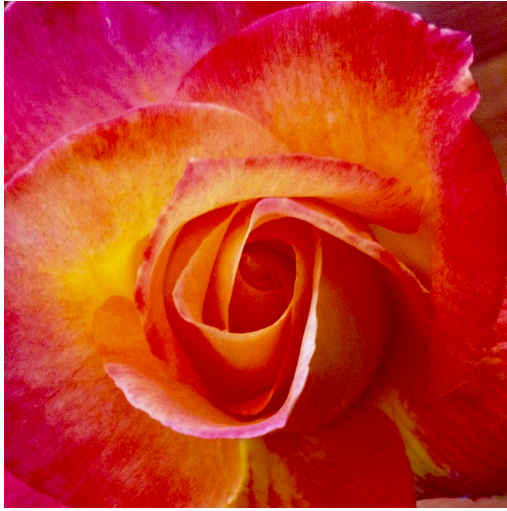

San Juan County WSU Master Gardeners 2021 Gardening Workshop Series

Please join us for the San Juan County WSU Master Gardener Annual Gardening Workshop presented again in 2021 as a Gardening Workshop Series. The lectures are a series of webinars, provided by Zoom. It is open to **all gardeners!**

The 2021 Gardening Workshop Series will be held in October 2021. The sessions start with two sessions on Saturday morning, October 16, and again on Tuesday, October 19, Thursday, October 21 and Tuesday, October 26. We are offering eight (8) one hour presentations with additional time after each for questions and discussion.
