

Zoning By-law Parking Requirements Review - Public Meetings

New and expanded developments in Toronto are required to provide automobile and bicycle parking based on standards in zoning by-laws. The City of Toronto is currently reviewing the parking requirements in the city-wide Zoning By-law 569-2013. The review responds to growing interest in the impacts of parking on housing affordability and travel behaviour and recognizes that the current zoning standards have not been reviewed recently. The recommended approach to this review was reported to Planning and Housing Committee January 19 ([see agenda & history here](#)).

The City will be holding a series of online public meetings at the start of June to gather feedback on our emerging directions. The feedback received will inform recommendations for revised parking rates. The meetings are:
