The AT Teams will work collaboratively to assist a child with a disability and the IEP team with the selection, acquisition and use of an assistive technology (AT) device.

- No fee to apply or participate
- Approximately. 1-3 hours per week of course material and additional time outside course to meet and work with team
- **Course 1**: 8 weeks Sept. 13 Nov. 14, 2021 This course will help develop a cohesive AT Team, including creating and revising policy documents and conducting assessments.
- Course 2: 6 weeks Jan. 10 Feb. 20, 2022 This course will help AT Teams implement their new assessment process, with topics to include AT in IEP, goal writing, device training, and transition planning.



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
