Overview: Provide professional counseling for clients of all ages affected by domestic violence, sexual assault, and/or child abuse. Experience in the fields of domestic violence, sexual assault, or child abuse. Work as a member of the team to provide inclusive services as needed. Maintain client files as required.

Responsibilities:

- Provide some, initial, non-clinical documentation as needed to meet the requirements of funding sources.
- Willingness to participate in peer file checks during weekly client staffing with the clinical team.
- Conduct regular counseling and therapy sessions with clients of all ages.
- Facilitate group sessions.
- Organize specialty groups according to the needs of clients.
- Knowledge of therapeutic techniques such as play therapy, art therapy, and sand tray therapy.
- Maintain confidentiality.
- Other duties as needed.
