Here's your chance! In the New Year our atrium leaders will host a series of one hour discussions on Zoom about the philosophy, theology, and practices that form the core of our approach to children's spiritual formation called the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd.

These discussions are offered as an introduction to the more extensive Level I training course for those who are interested in the 3 to 6 age group which will begin meeting later in the year on Sunday afternoons.

- March 26 – Essential Elements of the Liturgy for the 3 to 6 year-old child
