Lucy Newman was a truly kind, thoughtful, delightful person who deeply impacted the lives of her family, husband, and friends. She had an impeccable eye for beauty and design, loved to host and bring people together, and she showed up for people in remarkable ways. A Chicagoan through and through, she was born and raised in the city and made a life with her husband, Daniel, in Ravenswood. Following a healthy pregnancy with her first baby, Lucy developed a condition that required emergency c-section. About a week after giving birth to her healthy girl, Daisy, Lucy went into septic shock and spent two days on life support, where doctors attempted to save her through (among every other means possible) constant blood transfusions. The day that she passed away, September 11 2023, also happened to be the day that the American Red Cross declared an emergency blood shortage, with blood donations now being at a 20 year low. As her friends and greater community, we are grateful for this tangible opportunity to honor her life and give back in an important way.
