

In RE COVID-19 PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES

WHEREAS, on March 9 and March 15, 2020, the Superior Court entered Standing Order Nos. 1 and 2 Concerning COVID-19 Precautionary Measures in the interest of protecting jurors, parties, witnesses, lawyers, judges and court staff;

WHEREAS, the Superior Court has reviewed the requests by judges of this Court for “courtesy” copies to be submitted to chambers for ease of reference by judges and has concluded that these requests should be suspended until further notice.

1. In civil actions, Lawyers shall not submit paper copies or provide “courtesy” copies to chambers of any documents that have been electronically filed with the Court, unless a judge makes a specific request subsequent to this Standing Order for paper copies.

2. In criminal actions, Lawyers shall not submit additional paper copies or provide “courtesy” copies to chambers of any documents that have been conventionally filed with the Prothonotary, unless a judge makes a specific request subsequent to this Standing Order for paper copies.
