

TTN trip to BELEN and The Harvey House Museum - Saturday, Oct. 28

When : Saturday, October 28

Where : meet at South Capitol Santa Fe Rail Runner Station at 1301 Alta Vista (near Cordova Road) @ 10 am. There is lots of free parking.

Cost : 1.00 for train trip (you can pay on the train), plus lunch in Belen

We'll take the Rail Runner from Santa Fe to Belen. The train leaves at 10:25 am and arrives in Belen at 12:30 pm.

We'll walk to Pete's Café for lunch, and have a few more hours to explore Belen and visit The Harvey House Museum. <http://www.belen-nm.gov/belen-harvey-house-museum.aspx>. Fred Harvey is credited with creating a desire to and way of exploring the South West at the turn of the last century. Famous hotels like La Fonda in Santa Fe, La Posada in Winslow, AZ, and The Casteneda (currently being restored in Las Vegas, NM) were all Harvey hotels. The Harvey Girls, renowned for their professional and efficient service, staffed the hotels and restaurants, inspiring a movie starring Judy Garland in the 1940's.

Return train leaves Belen at 5:40 and arrives back in Santa Fe at 7:42 pm. This will be a fun, relaxing adventure, with lots of time to chill and visit.
