A1221 Requires emergency contact information and access instructions for social services hotline to be provided to tenants of multiple dwellings. **Substituted by S1148 and passed**

A1229 Requires DCA to make information on homeless prevention programs and services available on its Internet website. **Concurred w/ Governor's Recommendations and Passed**

A1259 Requires pharmacy benefits manager providing services within Medicaid program to disclose certain information to DHS. **Substituted by S249 and passed**

A1380 Requires residential landlords to install protective covers on steam radiators. **Combined with A869 and substituted by S399 and passed**

A1385 Requires members of governing boards of public institutions of higher education to complete training program developed by institution in consultation with Secretary of Higher Education. **Substituted by S970 and passed**

A1536 Concerns sign fabrication and prevailing wage requirements. **Substituted by S3844 and passed**

A1599 Requires public school students with concussion to be evaluated by licensed health care professionals before return to school; requires school districts to provide restrictions or limitations to student as needed. **Passed**

A1971 Directs BPU to develop and implement electric school bus pilot program. **Passed**

A2186 Establishes Statewide database of beds in shelters for the homeless. **Passed**

A2285 Establishes standard medical expense deduction under SNAP for certain senior citizens. **Passed**

A2311 [bill added] Establishes study commission to examine development of mutually beneficial relationships between institutions of higher education and municipalities. **Concurred w/ Senate Amendments and Passed**

A2374 Directs EDA to establish program for public or private financing of certain renewable energy, water, and storm resiliency projects through use by municipalities of voluntary special assessments for certain property owners.

A2628 Concerns labor contractors. **Substituted by S1259 and passed**

A2877 Requires registration of certain vacant and abandoned properties with municipalities and provides enforcement tools related to maintenance of these properties. **Passed**

A3007 Requires institutions of higher education to provide students with access to mental health care programs and services and to establish a hotline to provide information concerning the availability of those services. **Passed**

A3142 Revises certain licensure requirements to operate water supply and wastewater treatment systems. **Passed**

A3149 Requires institutions of higher education and public and nonpublic high schools and middle schools to adopt anti-hazing policies; expands activities encompassing criminal hazing and upgrades penalties for engaging in these activities. **Received floor amendment**

A3633 Establishes requirements concerning the provision of postpartum care information and the development of individualized postpartum care plans. **Passed**

A3872 Requires institutions of higher education and proprietary degree-granting institutions to provide transparency of tuition and fees to prospective and current students. **Substituted by S1877 and passed**

A3874 Prohibits sale of paint or coating removal products that contain methylene chloride unless purchaser meets certain safety standards for use. **Substituted by S894 and Passed**

A4008 Provides secondary classroom experience credit towards meeting requirements of classroom training portion of registered apprenticeship. **Passed**

A4058 Prohibits law enforcement agencies from considering number of arrests made and citations issued when evaluating police officer's professional performance. **Substituted by S1322 and passed**

A4238 Establishes minimum Medicaid reimbursement rate for adult medical day care services. **Passed**

A4250 [bill added] Revises law concerning notaries and notarial acts; authorizes electronic signatures. **Concurred w/ Senate Amendments and Passed**

A4265 Revises law relating to common interest communities. **Substituted by S2261 and passed**

A4274 Expands powers and duties of State Chief Diversity Officer to promote diversity in State government and public contracting. **Substituted by S2525 and passed**

A4330 "Economic Emergency Investment Stabilization Act"; allows EDA to invest in businesses impacted by major economic emergencies. **Passed**

A4393 Increases maximum penalty for certain violations concerning asbestos hazard abatement; allocates moneys from increased penalties to asbestos control and licensure programs. **Received Floor Amendments**

A4433 [bill added] Creates grant program to encourage school districts to partner with institutions of higher education in training school-based mental health services providers. **Concurred w/ Senate Amendments and Passed**

A4517 Requires Civil Service Commission establish mentoring program for minority civil service law enforcement applicants. **Received Floor Amendments**

A4521 Allows insurer to submit to MVC power of attorney executed electronically for certificate of ownership or salvage certificate of title by person who received or is due to receive total loss settlement from insurer. **Held**

A4530 Provides that New Jersey residents have access to one cost-free postpartum home visit. **Held**

A4542 Requires Civil Services Commission to undertake various initiatives to increase diversity and inclusivity within law enforcement agencies. **Received Floor Amendments**

A4543 Requires civil service commission to notify a certified eligible by certified mail and via electronic mail. **Passed**

A4544 [bill added] Permits school nurse who is retired from TPAF to return to employment for up to two years without reenrollment in TPAF. **Concurred w/ Senate Amendments and Passed**

A4551 Authorizes insurers issuing business interruption insurance to offer rider for global virus transmission and pandemic coverage. **Passed**

A4831 Clarifies classification in this State of criminal offenses committed in other states or under federal law. **Substituted by S3953 and passed**

A4869 Requires certain bidders for prevailing wage public work to provide proof that prevailing wage will be paid. **Received floor amendments**

A4906 Allows minors to serve as election workers between 5:30 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. on elections days. **Received floor amendments**

A5008 "Stillbirth Resource Center" and programs for the prevention and reduction of incidences of stillbirth; expands list of professionals authorized to provide stillbirth-related care. **Received floor amendments**

A5018 Requires DEP to prioritize funding for environmental infrastructure projects for applicants with established program to employ, at project or related facilities, local residents or residents of nearby urban aid qualifying municipalities. **Passed**

S3491 (Vitale / Lagana) - Revises and expands authorization for any person or entity to obtain, distribute, and administer opioid antidotes. **Passed**

A637 / S2670 (Caputo / Dancer / Houghtaling / Beach) - Revises permit and license processes for sports pools operators and online sports pool operators; revises definitions of certain sports events; allows for transactional waiver for sports wagering lounge.

A681 / S397 (Vainieri Huttel / McKnight / DeCroce / Weinberg / Turner) - Expands scope of law prohibiting age discrimination. **Passed**

A2311 / S356 (Calabrese / Jasey / Cryan / Codey) - Establishes study commission to examine development of mutually beneficial relationships between institutions of higher education and municipalities. **Passed**

A4861 / S3041 (Vainieri Huttel / Armato / Verrelli / Vitale / Gopal) - Requires DOH to publish total number of COVID-19 deaths and cases in long-term care facilities. **Passed**

A4909 / S3090 (Dancer / Caputo / Gopal / Sarlo) - Authorizes fixed odds wagering on horse races through fixed odds wagering system. **Passed with Amendments**

A4918 / S3266 (Greenwald / Johnson / Mukherji / Diegnan / Gopal) - Allows corporations to hold remote shareholder meetings. **Passed**

A5310 / S3597 (Lopez / Vitale) - Increases limit on number of social affairs permits that can be issued for one premises from 25 to 52 for designated premises owned by municipality or for event sponsored by municipality. **Passed**

A5343 / S3398 (Schaer / McKnight / Spearman / Singleton / Gopal / Greenstein) - Requires public community water systems to inventory and replace lead service lines within 10 years; provides for recoupment of costs by investor-owned public water systems. **Passed**
