Senate Voting Session:

S382 (Weinberg / Singleton) - Requires uniform response procedures for all domestic crisis teams established or participated in by law enforcement agencies, and strengthens Statewide supervision over teams; expands topics required in training courses. **Passed**

S383 (Weinberg / Singleton) - Establishes standards for Batterers' Intervention Programs in domestic violence cases. **Passed**

S384 (Weinberg / Singleton) - Establishes certain requirements for domestic violence training for certain judges, judicial personnel, and law enforcement. **Passed**

S385 (Weinberg / Singleton) - Requires training for law enforcement officers and assistant county prosecutors concerning handling of domestic violence cases. **Passed**

S386 (Weinberg / Singleton) - Establishes mandatory domestic violence training for municipal prosecutors. **Passed**

S690 (Ruiz / Vitale) - Establishes Statewide universal newborn home nurse visitation program in DCF; appropriates \$2.75 million. **Passed**

S1147 (Ruiz / Cruz-Perez) - Requires lead paint inspection on certain residential rental property, including upon tenant turnover; establishes lead-based paint hazard education program; appropriates \$3,900,000. **Passed**

S2022 (Sarlo / Cunningham) - Appropriates \$46,380,012,000 in State funds and \$21,026,030,082 in federal funds for the State budget for fiscal year 2021-2022. **Passed**

S2078 (Weinberg / Addiego) - Establishes "Stillbirth Resource Center" and regional Fetal and Infant Mortality Review Committee, and programs for the prevention and reduction of incidences of stillbirth; expands list of professionals authorized to provide stillbirth-related care. **Passed**

S2515 (Smith / Greenstein) - Establishes postconsumer recycled content requirements for rigid plastic containers, glass containers, paper and plastic carryout bags, and plastic trash bags; prohibits sale of polystyrene loose fill packaging. **Passed**

S3358 (Pou) - Requires DCA to establish standards for prisoner reentry transitional housing.

S3458 (Lagana / Gopal) - Revises out-of-network arbitration process. **Passed**

S3501 (Testa / Madden) - Exempts certain commercial fishermen from coverage under "unemployment compensation law." **Passed**

S3600 (Sacco / Singleton / Ruiz) - Restores and revises Urban Enterprise Zone program; appropriates \$42,500,000. **Substituted by A5580 and Passed**

S3633 (Kean / Diegnan) - Increases income eligibility limits for PAAD program and Senior Gold Prescription Discount Program by \$10,000. **Substituted by A5520 and Passed**

S3683 (Ruiz / Gopal) - Requires institutions of higher education to provide certain student loan information. **Passed**

S3691 (Stack / Rice / Ruiz) - Provides financial relief to certain landlords and tenants in response to COVID-19 pandemic, adjusts certain court fees; and makes appropriations. **Passed**

S3798 (Vitale) - Eliminates premiums and waiting periods for certain NJ FamilyCare enrollees and directs DHS to implement additional targeted outreach initiatives to increase enrollment. **Passed**

S3810 (Sweeney / Addiego / Greenstein) - "Responsible Collective Negotiations Act."

S3926 (Sweeney / Smith) - Authorizes certain offshore wind projects to construct power lines and obtain real property interests; grants BPU authority to supersede certain local governmental powers upon petition from offshore wind project. **Passed**

S3939 (Gopal / Cryan) - Allows law enforcement officers to review body worn camera recordings prior to creating initial report. **Substituted by A5864 and Passed**

S3941 (Vitale / Gopal) - Directs DHS to develop mobile software program for SNAP recipients; appropriates \$2 million. **Substituted by A5880 and Passed**

S3943 (Vitale / Madden) - Establishes State supplement for federal summer food service program meals. **Substituted by A5882 and Passed**

S3944 (Ruiz / Turner) - Establishes State supplement for "breakfast after the bell" meals. **Substituted by A5883 and Passed**

S3945 (Vitale / Madden) - Establishes Office of Food Insecurity Advocate. **Passed**

S3949 (Sarlo / Cunningham) - FY 2021 State supplemental appropriation; appropriates \$100.3 million in General Fund monies and \$14.4 million in Property Tax Relief Fund monies. **Passed**

S3954 (Sarlo / Sweeney) - Provides partial pension and retirement income exclusion for taxpayers with income between \$100,000 and \$150,000. **Substituted by A5539 and Passed**

S3955 (Ruiz) - Establishes "Rental Assistance Navigation Program" in DCA; makes appropriation. **Passed**

S3982 (Addiego / Greenstein) - Makes \$135 million in federal funds available to EDA to support eligible entities impacted by COVID-19 pandemic. **Passed**

S3984 (Sweeney / Turner) - Designates Department of Health State office building in Trenton as "Judith M. Persichilli Building." **Passed**

S3990 (Turner) - Establishes child care revitalization fund in Department of Community Affairs; appropriates \$100,000,000. **Concurred w/ Assembly Amendments and Passed**

S3993 (Ruiz / Cruz-Perez) - Revises various provisions of "New Jersey Economic Recovery Act of 2020" and other economic development programs; establishes New Jersey Innovation Fellows Program; appropriates \$10 million.

S3995 (Sweeney / Singleton) - Establishes School and Small Business Energy Efficiency Stimulus Program Fund in BPU. **Passed**

S3997 (Addiego / Cunningham) - "New Jersey College Affordability Act"; appropriates \$10 million. **Substituted by A12 and Passed**

S3998 (Sarlo) - Authorizes State Treasurer to determine salary of Director of Division of Investment. **Passed**

S3999 (Beach) - Authorizes Secretary of State and New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission to share voter and motor vehicle information with state-based non-profit organization for maintaining accuracy of voter registration information. **Passed**

S4000 (Sarlo / Sweeney) - Establishes "New Jersey Debt Defeasance and Prevention Fund," appropriates \$3.7 billion. **Substituted by A13 and Passed**

A1995 / S3149 (Pinkin / Downey / Pou / Turner) - Requires registration of international student exchange visitor placement organizations with Commissioner of Education. **Passed**

A2374 / S1953 (Mukherji / Pinkin / Smith / Bateman) - Directs EDA to establish program for public or private financing of certain renewable energy, water, and storm resiliency projects through use by municipalities of voluntary special assessments for certain property owners. **Passed**

A4139 / S2893 (Benson / Vainieri Huttel / Verrelli / Pou) - Establishes requirements for copies of medical and billing records to be provided without charge to Social Security Disability benefits applicants and recipients. **Passed**

A4253 / S3233 (Conaway / Pinkin / Jimenez / Cryan) - Requires certain electronic medical programs to include demographic data entry feature; requires laboratories to record certain patients' demographic information; requires certain hospitals and laboratories to implement cultural competency training program. **Passed**

A4367 / S2794 (Mukherji / Sumter / Taliaferro / Pou / Scutari) - Provides that AOC shall administer program for municipal courts allowing defendants to engage in online plea negotiations, entry of guilty plea, and payment of fine or penalty. **Passed**

A4881 / S3744 (Greenwald / Mazzeo / Beach) - Prohibits appeal of land use decision related to holding meeting electronically. **Passed**

A5075 / S4001 (Burzichelli / Dancer / Johnson / Sweeney) - Removes Fire Museum and Fallen Firefighters Memorial from auspices of DEP and establishes museum as independent organization; makes \$200,000 supplemental appropriation. **Passed**

A5121 / S3287 (Coughlin / Zwicker / Karabinchak / Singleton / Smith) - Concerns provision of energy to certain manufacturing facilities by providing exemptions to certain energy related taxes. **Passed**

A5207 / S3361 (Johnson / Reynolds-Jackson / Carter / Weinberg / Gill) - Prohibits State and local entities and private detention facilities from entering into agreement to detain noncitizens. **Passed**

A5231 / S3382 (Lopez / Coughlin / Freiman / Vitale) - Allows county or municipal governing body to enter into revenue sharing agreement for alcoholic beverage sales by concessionaire permit holder. **Passed**

A5345 / S3428 (Reynolds-Jackson / Mukherji / Vainieri Huttel / Lagana / Ruiz) - Expands eligibility under New Jersey earned income tax credit program to allow taxpayers who are at least 18 years of age or older to qualify for modified benefit. **Passed**
