The Holiness we are called to, as a result of our salvation calls us to share with those around us. 2 Corinthians 5:20 the Apostle Paul states, "We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making His appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: be reconciled to God."

Salvation comes with a responsibility. Don't let the potential result or lack thereof hinder you. Invite, inform, offer and share. God takes care of the rest. As we are qualified to know, we are qualified to share.
