

The COVID-19 pandemic has continued to change our lives in so many ways. The **Northeast Regional Coalition** in collaboration with the **Terrorism and Disaster Coalition for Child and Family Resilience** is again asking you to complete a survey to learn about the impact of COVID-19 on teachers, school administrators and others, related to their own families, as well concerns for the children they teach now both in person and virtually.

The survey is anonymous and will take about 5 minutes to complete. The results will be used to educate public and private systems about the experiences and unmet needs of educators.
