Our new, combined organization will be one of the largest social services agencies committed to ending homelessness across Los Angeles County, and will be led by John Maceri, OPCC's current Executive Director.

Who We Serve:

95% are living with a mental illness
65% have significant physical health problems
50% have a substance addiction
87% of chronically homeless women are victims of molestation, domestic violence or sexual assault
70% of young people who become homeless do so to escape physical or sexual abuse in their home
65% of former foster youth end up homeless

95% of those housed through our programs STAY HOUSED!
