

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS...

Last weekend we officially launched St. Louis de Montfort's Growing Together Toward Heaven Capital Campaign – a critical effort to raise funds for our new church and adoration chapel. A packet of materials about our campaign were mailed to all registered families this past week. This packet includes a case statement booklet along with a letter from Father Haan requesting a pledge to the effort. Over the coming weeks, our team of volunteers will be reaching out to families to discuss the campaign, answer questions and seek your support. We may not be able to personally contact every family, but we do hope that all families will choose to participate in this important campaign.



Over the past several weeks, we have continued to share answers to some frequently asked questions. We will continue to provide those answers as we move forward, so please be sure to contact our campaign team with any additional questions you may have!

- **How did you come up with my request amount?**

The amounts are based on a number of factors, including giving history and answers shared in the planning study. Our goal is to challenge everyone to consider supporting St. Louis de Montfort in a meaningful and sacrificial way, in a manner that works for each family.

- **Who is being asked to support the campaign?**

Every registered parish family will be asked to participate in the campaign.

- **Why should I/we consider supporting the campaign?**

Throughout the scriptures we are reminded that we have been called by the Lord to build His kingdom.

"Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain." 1 Corinthians 15:58.

This project doesn't fall on the shoulders of one family or a few. It is the responsibility of everyone at St. Louis de Montfort to hear God's call and to continue to grow His ministry. The obligation rests with everyone to do their part to make sacrificial commitments to
