Kindergarten / Carriage House Kids Lesson Plans January 15 - 19, 2018

Language Arts: New word family: an. We will be doing some letter and word assessments during reading groups this week. For this reason, you may not see new books in Boomerangs. Students will learn about and model use of our new reading nook! They will practice high-frequency words with some new games. During Writer's Workshop, students will practice writing sentences that tell a true story, learn that writers re-read, and learn to use a vowel chart as a writing tool to help with the middle of words.

<u>Math</u>: Children will identify and sort shapes as 2D or 3D and recognize them in different orientations. We will spend a couple of days on the End-of-Module Assessment and play some games involving shapes and patterns.

<u>Art</u>: We added paint dots around our paper concentric circles inspired by Aboriginal art.

Music: We will learn about rhythm.

<u>Spanish</u>: Last week we focused on conversation with greetings and introductions, asking and answering questions such as What is your name? What is your father/mother/sister/brother's name, How many sisters/brothers do you have? This week we will do the same with questions such as Where do you live? Where do you go to school?

<u>Wellness</u>: We will be outside sliding for PE. We are going to watch short movies on growth mindset and talk about the many ways to succeed.
