

7th Grade Lesson Plans
November 13-17, 2017

English: We'll continue to read, discuss, and write about *Huck Finn*. There will be a vocabulary quiz on Wednesday.

Pre-Algebra: We will be finishing up Chapter 3: Expressions and Equations. There will be a two-part assessment on Wednesday and Thursday.

Algebra I: Students will be teaching the first 3 sections of chapter 3 to their classmates. This chapter discovers inequalities where behavior is much like solving equalities. We will finish this week with a lab.

American History: We'll look at the Declaration of Independence and the early days of the American Revolution.

Life Science: They will begin their study of the immune system this week. They will research a contagious disease as part of this unit.

Spanish A: We will continue practicing vocabulary about activities; and we will introduce the object pronouns, which are used to describe to whom a particular activity is pleasing (Spanish does not have to verb "to like).

Spanish B: We'll describe members of your families and activities they enjoy and learn how to use comparatives to talk about them.

Spanish C: We'll continue using stem change e - ie verbs to talk about our preferences in clothes and we'll continue practicing shopping conversations.

Latin: We'll continue our passage translation and geographical work.

Music: We will prepare for the Winter Concert.

Art: We finished our fun food packaging design. We started printing the background for our 4-part design based on Andy Warhol's "Flowers".

PE: They will continue to play running and hiding games this week.
