7th Grade Lesson Plans January 15 - 19, 2018

<u>English</u>: We'll continue to read, discuss, write about, and perform *A Midsummer Night's Dream* this week. The students will also work on personal essays. There will be a vocabulary quiz on Thursday.

<u>American History</u>: The students will put together projects on the Bill of Rights before we move into a study of early problems in our new country.

<u>Life Science</u>: They will begin exploring the excretory system this week. They may be ready for a test by the end of the week. Their data analysis on heart rates is due Friday.

<u>Pre-Algebra</u>: We will do a little bit more work with proportions. Then we will review what we know about ratios, rates, and proportions. There will be a quiz on Friday. <u>Algebra</u>: This week we finish linear systems with a test on <u>Friday</u>. We will, however, begin a study of function notation and an analysis of step and discontinuous functions. Olympic projects are due Wednesday, January 18th.

<u>Latin</u>: We'll be looking at the story of the Trojan War in the *Aeneid*.

<u>Spanish A</u>: We only meet once this week, and we'll be having a quiz on numbers #11-100. Students will also be introduced to the irregular verb "tener," to have.

Spanish B: We'll continue talking about clothing and learn shopping vocabulary.

<u>Spanish C</u>: We'll talk about places where we can go for fun and practice new vocabulary. We'll learn to use the verb "ir" (to go) + a second verb.

<u>Art</u>: We added color to our 2-view Op art designs. We are also working on auction items.

<u>Music</u>: As we enter the Classical Era in our journey through music history, we will explore theme and variations form and experiment with creating our own variations on melodies.

<u>PE</u>: They will continue the snowplay unit. If the weather won't let us be outside, we will play dodgeball inside.
