

6th Grade Lesson Plans

November 13-17, 2017

English: The kids will work on projects and reports in response to their independent reading books. We'll also begin reading *The Dark Is Rising*, and there will be a vocabulary quiz on Thursday.

Math: We will learn how to write our own algebraic expressions. There will be a quiz covering 3.1 & 3.2 on Thursday.

Ancient History: Weather permitting, we'll do an archaeological dig on campus this week, practicing the three stages of the work done by archaeologists as we studied in class. We'll also learn more about Sumer.

Physical Science: They will review the year's content and check in with their BBoS's. Then they will begin learning about energy. They will work on a potential energy car Thursday.

Spanish A: We will continue practicing vocabulary about activities; and we will introduce the object pronouns, which are used to describe to whom a particular activity is pleasing (Spanish does not have to verb "to like).

Latin: We'll continue our passage translation and geographical work.

Music: We will prepare for the Winter Concert.

Art: We are combining printmaking and paper weaving. We made our printing plate today.

PE: They will continue to play running and hiding games this week.
