

3rd Grade / Allee's Angels Lesson Plans

December 18 - December 20, 2017

Language Arts/ Social Studies: We'll be finishing our Mythology folders, preparing and practicing our character speeches, and reading a few more myths over the next couple of days. We will have had a spelling assessment this morning too.

Math: We will spend the next couple of days doing our Module 2 Assessment and making 6-pointed snowflakes with coffee filters. Will continue to work on our January 2018 calendar.

Science: We will continue an exploration of magnets this week. We will spend time talking about and exploring things that are magnetic and things that aren't. We'll practicing prediction and recording results.

Keyboarding: Students continue to work independently through their lessons. They may work at home, too, but this is not assigned as homework. Please be sure to help your student with correct finger placement if they do decide to work on developing their typing skills.

Spanish: Given that over 70% of Latin America is Catholic* this week we will be learning about Christmas traditions in the region, ranging from food to carrolls and celebrations. *Source: Pew Research Center.

Art: We are designing stupas from India using oil pastels and watercolors.
