

# Colleges Are Visiting!

## What Does That Mean?

September through December, you can register to attend college visits from Admissions Representatives.

During these visit sessions, Admissions Representatives will be available for 45 minutes to present about their college, answer questions about application requirements, and offer insight into the application process.


### Why Attend a Visit?

- Did you know that the Admissions Representative might be the person **reading your application**? Introducing yourself to the Representative puts a face to your application and demonstrates your interest in attending the college. Be sure to tell them your name, grade, and if you have or plan to apply.




### How to Prepare for a Visit

- Do some background research on the college. Know a few key facts such as the location and what interests you about the college.
- Have 1-2 questions prepared. Some Representatives prepare a presentation, but some may just be there to answer questions.



### Example Questions to Ask

- Do you review applicants based on their major, or are admissions requirements the same for every major?
- Is your school test optional and if so, do you need to submit test scores to be considered for scholarships?



### After The Visit

- Write down any important information you learned during the session.
- Send a thank you email to the Representative. Be sure to re-introduce yourself and jog their memory of you by mentioning something you discussed.
